

Student Driver Guidelines

Rationale

Year 11 and 12 Students who have obtained their provisional driver's license may apply to drive to and from the college. Application forms must be collected from the Senior School Office and returned before students are permitted to drive to and from school, or carry passengers.

Guidelines

The following rules apply to all student drivers:

- 1. The speed limit on campus is 10 km per hour. This applies as soon as you enter the front gates.
- 2. All student drivers must park in the allocated areas for student drivers.
- 3. No students are to access students' cars during the school day, other than when arriving at the start of the day and leaving school at the end of the school day.
- 4. Student drivers may only carry passengers that have completed the appropriate parental consent for traveling with a student driver. These forms are kept at the Senior School office and must be completed before student drivers are able to carry passengers.

All student drivers are expected to arrive at school in time to be present for roll call (8:20am) and may only leave early if they:

- 1. Are in Year 12
- 2. Have completed an early leave form
- 3. Have no further classes for the day
- 4. Have signed out at the Student Services office
