Junior School Student Acceptable Use of ICT Facilities

The Junior School one to one program has been designed to introduce the student to computer use and to guide the student into becoming a proficient and responsible digital citizen.

The rules to be followed by Junior School students when using MC ICT facilities are:

- 1. I will get teacher permission before I begin using the Network, Internet or Intranet and I will follow all the rules set up by my teacher and other MC staff.
- 2. I will only visit websites directly related to my school assignments.
- 3. I will list the sources of all information and images used in my reports and will respect copyright laws.
- 4. I will always use appropriate, polite language on the Internet and Intranet.
- 5. I will not download or display offensive or inappropriate messages or pictures.
- 6. I will never give out my last name, phone number, home address or home email address over the internet.
- 7. I will tell a teacher immediately if I come across something that I think is inappropriate or wrong.
- 8. I will not damage any computers, computer systems, or computer accessories.
- 9. I will not trespass in other people's folders, work or files.
- 10. I will not use other people's network account passwords.

Violation may result in:

- 1. Removal of computer privileges.
- 2. Disciplinary action in line with existing Junior School rules regarding inappropriate language or behaviour.
- 3. A charge incurred for cost of repair of damaged or lost equipment.
