Further to the previous MC COVID-19 update published on 24 July, please note the additional requirements below.

[Advice to Families/Students Travelling to/Returning from areas where a COVID-19 Outbreak Occurs](#)

Over the past days and weeks, there has been a series of COVID-19 localised outbreaks, both within NSW and interstate. Within that context, the NSW Government Minister for Health regularly publishes both advice and requirements in relation to people who have either travelled or are intending to travel, to such locations. Typically such advice is referenced in mainstream media but is also available from the [NSW Health website](#).

Macquarie College families are encouraged to monitor the advice provided by the Minister for Health, particularly in circumstances where they have travelled or are intending to travel to an area which has or is experiencing such an outbreak. In such circumstances, families are encouraged to either alter their travel plans or, upon their return, commence the required self-isolation period stipulated by the Minister.

In the event that a student attends school after having travelled to such an outbreak area, Macquarie College will require such a student to complete any self-isolation period required by the Minister. In such circumstances, support will be provided to ensure that any such students are able to continue their studies remotely as appropriate to the circumstances.

Please be conscious that Macquarie College is committed to maintaining a safe environment for students, staff and visitors and your support of the above advice will assist us in that process.

As always, we will continue to monitor the current Government advice in relation to the COVID-19 outbreak and provide further updates as relevant to our community.
